

Guidance for the 9th Training Course on Ship's Health Supervisor in 2009

Seamen's Employment Center of Japan

This is a guide for the captioned Training Course on Ship's Health Supervisor to obtain a certificate of the Japanese Ship's Health Supervisor on board Japanese flag ocean-going vessels.

This Training Course is to be conducted by Seamen's Employment Center of Japan (SECOJ) registered with the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism Japan.

4. Applicants who can take the course

① Those who hold valid Medical Care Certificates in accordance with Regulation VI/4 para.2, STCW Convention.

(Medical First Aid Certificate in accordance with Regulation VI/4 para.1, STCW Convention holders are not entitled to apply this course.)

- ② Applicants should be twenty (20) years and more of age on the day of this course.

5. Application procedure

(1) Document for application

Following documents shall be submitted to SECOJ Tokyo by mail, together with fee to take the course.

- ① Application form for Training Course on Ship's Health Supervisor as attached Form No.1.

- ② Two sheets of an applicant's photograph (taken within 6 months, no cap, head & shoulder, the size should be 4cm x 3cm, mentioned full name in on the backside)
- ③ A copy of the pages which contains applicant's photo of his/her passport or a copy of document which proves full name, sex, nationality and the date of birth approved by the government.
- ④ A copy of Medical Care Certificate in accordance with Regulation VI/4 para.2, STCW Convention.
- ⑤ Others
- A self-addressed envelope of A4 size with equivalent amount of stamp(s) for plain registered mail.
 - A Copy of the pages which contains applicant's name of his Mariner's Pocket Ledger, i.e. Seaman's Book called "Orange Book" in Japan.
(Submission of this copy is required for those who has been issued a Japanese Mariner's Pocket Ledger before.)

6. Criteria for issuing a completion certificate

- Standard to pass the completion exam. is that the score of each subject (Regulations on labor safety and sanitation and health guidance) is 50 % or more and total score is 70 % or more. If examinees fail to the completion examination, re-examination will be carried out.

7. Notice

- Attendance at the all 12 hours course is compulsory for completion of the course.
- Those who failed to attend any part of the lecture and exercises or to pass the completion examination are not entitled to be issued completion certificate.
- Trainees are requested to muster at K-Line Maritime Academy. 15 minutes before the starting time of both course (15th/16th March 2010).
- Trainees shall carry their ID cards and show them at the reception desk. Failure to carry the ID card may result in failure to take the examination.
